#### **Eurodoc**

On 11 March the European Commission adopted a <u>European Charter for Researchers and a Code of Conduct for the Recruitment of Researchers</u>. These two documents are key elements in the EU's policy to make research an attractive career, which is a vital feature of its strategy to stimulate economic and employment growth. The Charter and Code of Conduct will give individual researchers the same rights and obligations wherever they may work throughout the EU. This should help counter the fact that research careers in Europe are fragmented at local, regional, national or sectoral level, and allow Europe to make the most of its scientific potential. One member from Eurodoc was represented in the group.

Conference: "To Strengthen the Ethical Aspects of Knowledge in Society".

The Hungarian Academy of Sciences, in partnership with UNESCO and ICSU, will organize the next World Science Forum - Budapest on 10-12 November 2005. The Forum at this time will focus on Knowledge, Ethics and Responsibility and it will tackle the ethical aspects of knowledge and the responsibility of scientists and decision makers in the global society of the 21st century. SiN members are free to participate along with other European young scientists.
