Background

The numbers of people holding a doctorate degree are rising

Their training mainly prepares them for a career in academia

Only few of them will obtain a secured position in academia

Due to the economic crisis, job opportunities as well as funding have in many countries been reduced

The European Young Researchers' Platform

Many European countries are currently addressing obstacles in research career development

Many institutions and associations are actively involved in improving the situation of young researchers (contributors)

Efforts to help young researchers are sometimes duplicated by different organizations
